To: The Heads of all recognized Government, Non Government Aided and un aided Madrasahs

**Sub:** Suspension of classes to combat Corona Virus (COVID-19)

In pursuance to orders and guidelines issued by the Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education Department, Government of West Bengal vide No.11-MD-15011/23/2021 Date:03.01.2022 read with No.753/XVII-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 02.01.2022 of the Government of West Bengal and in view of the prevailing situation and to combat the spread of Corona virus, this is to inform that all Government & Non Government aided and un aided Madrasahs will remain closed until further order in public interest. However, the academic activities will continue online and via alternative modes, until further instructions. Teachers may visit the houses of students to oversee academic activities & provide suitable guidance.

2. Administrative departments of Madrasahs, like the offices of heads of the institutes including emergency services like. Electricity, cleanliness, water supply, security etc. may remain open under strict Covid protocol, as per the extant guidelines issued from time to time & read with order stated above and as per the local need to be decided by the head of the institute.

3. Hostels will also remain closed until further order. Adequate arrangement as per medical protocol may be made by the respective Madrasahs for the students who are not able to leave the campus due to distance or otherwise. No visitor should be allowed during the period to visit hostel, without prior approval of the head of the Madrasah.

4. Adequate arrangements for vaccination programme for the students between 15+ till 18 years of age group shall be made by the Head of the Madrasah at the institute. Teachers may be requested to assist in smooth conduct of the vaccination programme as per the need and assessment made by the respective Head of the Madrasahs.

5. Distribution of Mid day meal, wherever applicable will continue as being done during COVID times, along with distribution of books, khatas etc. to the guardians/parents maintaining COVID protocols.

All Head of the Madrasahs are requested to take necessary action accordingly.
