Md. Salam, the Headmaster of the Bheramari A. M. High Madrasah, Birbhum, specifically stated that the petitioner, Nazrul Islam has been working as Para Teacher in the Madrasah since 2007 at a monthly salary of Rs. 12,000/- and he has no knowledge about the resolution dated 25/05/2018. The D.I. of School, Birbum, has however, stated that the petitioner, Nazrul Islam was never recruited following the Rules of recruitment as per Govt. Notification No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016dated 03/03/2016.

Under the circumstances stated above, we are of the considered view that the petitioner, Nazrul Islam, having no requisite qualification and age to be appointed as Asstt. Teacher, was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. Notification No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03/03/2016 and he never worked as legally Asstt. Teacher in that Madrasah. However, he has been working since 2007 as Para Teacher at a monthly salary of Rs. 12,000/- in the Madrasah.
