The District Inspector of Schools, South 24 Parganas, has categorically stated that the Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. Order No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03/03/2016 were never complied with in the alleged recruitment of the petitioner.

On careful consideration of the material on record, order of the Hon'ble High Court, statement of D.I. of Schools, Superintendent and Secretary, Sk. Madrasah without any remuneration and having regard to his past service, the Managing Committee appointed him as Group-D Employee in the Madrasah on 20/12/2019.

Sabir Ali, the earlier Secretary of the Madrasah, has specifically stated that there was no valid Managing Committee after 09/02/2019 by the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court in WP No. 12468(W) of 2019 by its order dated 17/07/2019, has only permitted the Managing Committee to perform day to-day function in the administration of the Madrasah and not to take any policy decision or major financial decision. Recruitment of teachers or any non-teaching staff definitely creates financial burden upon the finance of the Madrasah as, well as upon the State Government. The West Bengal School (Control of Expenditure) Act, 2005, has been implemented, keeping in view of such financial burden of the State. It is apparent that the Rules of Recruitment, as per the Govt. Notification No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03/03/2016 were never complied with by the Managing Committee and there was no valid Managing Committee on 20/12/2019, as it appears from the order of the Hon'ble High Court, mentioned above. There is no signature of the petitioner in the official Attendance Register maintained by the Madrasah.

The District Inspector of Schools, South 24 Parganas also corroborated that the petitioner was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment and has also filed a separate report to that effect.

Considering the materials on record, we have no hesitation to say that the petitioner, Mizanur Rahaman Mufti was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment being No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03/03/2016 and he never worked in the Madrasah as legally recruited Gr. 'D' employee.
