Rofikuzzaman, Assistant Teacher, Physical Education (Pass) :- Despite issuance of successive notices, the petitioner did not turn up with the original documents for verification of the same by this committee. Office specifically reported that all the notices were duly served upon the petitioner. We have gone through the documents filed by the petitioner. The specific case that has been made out is that pursuant to meeting of Managing Committee dated 08.09.2015 the petitioner was appointed as Assistant Teacher of Physical Education at Debkunda High Madrasah at Murshidabad. The Teacher-in-Charge of Debkunda High Madrasah and the District-Inspector of School Murshidabad both have been examined. They have unequivocally stated that Md. In absence of original testimonials, we are not in a position to accept on the basis of Photostat copies of document about the authenticity of such document. The Attendance Register also does not depict the signature of the petitioner as Assistant Teacher of Debkunda High Madrasah. On the basis of such false photocopy of Resolution and photocopy of the Appointment Letter and Joining Report we are not in a position to accept that Md. Rofikuzzaman was recruited following the Rules of Recruitment in terms of Memo No. 93-SE/10R-14/2013 dated 9th February 2015. The claim of the petitioner Md. Rofikuzzaman cannot be accepted and he is not entitled to get any salary.
