


OBSERVATION


Priyanka Patra, Assistant Teacher (UG) : Except the letter of appointment, joining report (without any date and without any endorsement of Secretary) and Work Done Certificate (without any date), the petitioner could not produce any other documents to show that she was recruited following the Rules of Recruitment and that she has been working in the Madrasah since 14.06.2019.


Admittedly, the petitioner had no requisite qualification on the date of her alleged appointment. As per the statement of Nuruddin Mondal, the Teacher-in-Charge of the Madrasah, the petitioner never worked in such Madrasah and never signed in the official Attendance Register. In fact, the Teacher-in-Charge was forced by one Parvez Ahmed Mallick, son of member of Zilla Parishad to sign on the Work Done Certificate. The original Resolution Book was never handed over to the Teacher-in-Charge for the period 2015 to 13.12.2019.

In such circumstances, the copy of Resolution or the copy of Attendance Register filed by the petitioner without any certificate of competent authority and without having the originals there of, cannot be considered. It is apparent that there is no signature of the petitioner in the official Attendance Register at least from 2020 till date.

Under the circumstances stated above, we have no hesitation to say that the Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. Notification No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03.03.2016 were never complied with and the petitioner never worked as Assistant Teacher (UG) (having no requisite qualification).



OBSERVATION


Reshma Parveen, Assistant Teacher, Bengali (H/PG) : The petitioner simply has filed her representation stating *inter alia* that she was recruited as Assistant Teacher, Bengali (H/PG) in Marui Beria Ainul Ulum Sr. Madrasah, South 24 Parganas. The petitioner did not file any papers in support of her claim. The petitioner also did not turn up in person despite receipt of successive notices for appearance. Nuruddin Mondal, the Teacher-in-Charge also asserted that she never worked in the Madrasah as Assistant Teacher, Bengali (H/PG).

In absence of any document, we are of considered view that she was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. notification no. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03.03.2016 and she never worked in the Madrasah.








OBSERVATION


Sk. Md. Hedayetullah, Assistant Teacher History (Pass): Admittedly, the petitioner had no requisite qualification on the date of his alleged appointment. As per the statement of Nuruddin Mondal, the Teacher-in-Charge of the Madrasah, the petitioner never worked in such Madrasah and never signed in the official Attendance Register. In fact, the Teacher-in-Charge was forced by one Parvez Ahmed Mallick, son of member of Zilla Parishad to sign on the Work Done Certificate. The original Resolution Book was never handed over to the Teacher-in-Charge for the period 2015 to 13.12.2019.

In such circumstances, the copy of Resolution or the copy of Attendance Register filed by the petitioner without any certificate of competent authority and without having the originals there of, cannot be considered. It is apparent that there is no signature of the petitioner in the official Attendance Register at least from 2020 till date.

Under the circumstances stated above, we have no hesitation to say that the Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. Notification No. 93-SE/S/10R-14/2013 dated 09.02.2015 were never complied with and the petitioner never worked as Assistant Teacher, History (Pass) (having no requisite qualification).
