NOTIFICATION

I am directed to inform all Heads of Fazil Madrasahs in the state that the Board has already published the syllabus, question pattern and marks distribution of all subjects for Fazil semester examination for the academic Session 2024-25.

The total marks in Semester I and Semester III examinations in the Fazil (10+2) Course will be 40 and 35 for the Project-based and practical-based subjects.

Around 50% questions in these papers will be consisted of basic and simple questions. Around 30% questions will be bit more complex and the rest 20% will be comparatively bit tougher and will test the logical and analytical skills of the students along with their subject knowledge.

All the questions for Semester I and Semester III will be MCQs(Multiple Choice Questions) with four(4) alternatives/Options.

Along with simple Multiple Choice Questions with 4 options, there will also be questions of following types:

- Fill in the blanks
- Column Matching
- Assertion-Reasoning type
- Diagram based questions
- Rearrangement of Sentences on prescribed sequence
- True and False type questions
- Case based questions

The Board is not specifying any fixed percentage breakup for the type of questions in the Question paper of Semester I and Semester III examinations. This will entirely depend on the discretion of the paper setter(s) and will vary from subject to subject.
